Rules of membership

1. Rotary International is a non-denominational, apolitical, multi-racial organisation. Applications from political organisations will not be accepted. Applications are accepted on the basis that everyone will act with respect to all people whilst in Rotary.
2. Dues are payable annually in June, no later than 25th. Part payments if joining partway through a year or phased payments can be arranged with the Membership Secretary.
3. Full members of the Rotary Club (Rotarians) and Friends are expected to abide by the Constitution and Bylaws (available on request) and all policies and procedures with respect to club activities including youth.

5. For Corporate members, the Company may change its designated representatives by notifying the Secretary in writing, which includes by company email. However, one of its designated representatives must always be an Executive Director or equivalent of the organisation

Membership entitlements

- Subscribe to a Rotary magazine, either The Rotarian or Rotary Africa
- Visit other clubs
- Receive Assistant Governor (AG) and DG visits
- Attend Rotary meetings, e.g. District Conferences, RI Institutes, RI Convention etc
- Sponsor EarlyAct (primary), Interact (secondary school) & Rotaract (18-30) Clubs
- Apply for District and Global grants
- Take part in an international Rotary Friendship Exchange or other exchanges
- Take advantage of other opportunities through Rotary: e.g. visiting India to vaccinate children against polio)

Friends of Rotary Parys may well want to do some or all of the above. However, they may not be able to afford it. Hence, being a Friend provides the opportunity to be part of an extended Rotary family whilst serving their local community. Friends of Rotary Parys members can:-

- Meet for social events or other reasons (e.g braais at the Rotary Camp)
